As part of continuing efforts to reduce the environmental impact of cruising, **Norwegian** has initiated an innovative recycling program at the Port of Miami. Recently, about 1,300 gallons of used cooking oil from the **Norwegian Jewel** and the **Norwegian Pearl** were donated to an organic farm in Vero Beach, FL, where it was converted into 870 gallons of bio-diesel fuel to be used in farming equipment.

All Norwegian ships in Hawaii have been recycling used cooking oil, and more than 40,000 gallons were converted to bio-diesel last year alone. Additionally, the cruise line runs ongoing residual oil recycling programs in Alaska, British Columbia, New York and Charleston.
